The popular Star-Telegram writer was named exactly that by his peers in the National Society of Newspaper Columnists. The Lancaster Historical Society is honored to have Mr. Lieber as the featured speaker at their next general meeting, to be held on Sunday, March 20, 2005, at the historic MKT Depot in Lancaster. Refreshments will be served at 3:30 PM, and the business meeting will begin at 4:00 PM. Admission is free and the public is invited. Copies of Mr. Lieber's new book, "The Dog of My Nightmares," a collection of his best columns, will be available for purchase at the meeting, and a portion of the proceeds will benefit The Humane Society of North Texas.

The Lancaster Historical Society meets at the MKT Depot on the third Sunday of every other month. The Depot is located next to the railroad tracks on Pecan Street, just East of Centre Street. Meetings are free and open to the public, though LHS is always happy to add new members to its roster. Membership dues are only \$15 per year for an individual, or \$25 per year for a couple. The Society maintains the MKT Depot and adjacent Rose Garden, strives to keep local history alive for the enjoyment of the community as well as for the record books, and supports local efforts to preserve historic sites.
